The document below is a rubric that the Burke School District COVID Advisory Committee is recommending as a guide for the school board to use in revising its "Back to School Plan" on an ongoing basis, in response to the ever-changing COVID 19 situation. The actions or conditions described in the rubric are designed to be used as a guide and are not hard and fast rules. Ultimately, the Board of Education, under the recommendation the committee, school administration and legal counsel, will have to determine specific changes to the plan. The committee has recommended some trigger points, at which the board should consider revisions to the plan.
